

## Windows Vista networking: disable TCP auto-tuning guide

1. Click on Start, go to All Programs - Accessories



## 2. Open Command Prompt



3. In the Command Prompt type: netsh interface tcp set global autotuninglevel=disabled and press Enter



4. You will get an OK response. If not, repeat step 3.

5. In the command prompt, type: **netsh interface tcp show global** and press **Enter**
