

Windows networking: traceroute guide

- 1. Click on Start, go to Programs Accessories
- 2. Open up **Command Prompt**. You should see a window similar to the one below.



3. Type: tracert www.google.com and hit the Enter key on your keyboard.



4. It may take few minutes to finish the test. The result should look similar to the screen capture below.
